Purpose of the e-safety committee:-

- ✓ To review the e-safety policy every two years. This was completed by the previous committee and will not need reviewing until next year.
- ✓ To monitor e-safety incident log.
- ✓ To discuss training needs, including staff, parent/community awareness.
- ✓ To raise new community initiatives in response to training needs or as a result of polls/surveys.
- ✓ To coordinate annual events such as anti-bullying week or Safer Internet Day.

- **April Newsletter Item**:
We want to make you aware of a game called ROBLOX that your child might have on their iPad, computer or tablet (it's a bit like Minecraft with a virtual world and chat function). It looks completely harmless, however, there have been incidents where children have been asked some inappropriate questions by other users such as:
 - *Where do you live?*

- What is your phone number?
- What school do you go to?
- Can you send me a photo of yourself? If your child is playing this game unsupervised and chatting online, please be aware - the content of the chat may not be appropriate and it may be worth deleting off their device.

- **SD to mention this to all staff at the next staff meeting - where possible not to mention children's surnames:** This was discussed at the staff briefing held on Friday 10th March:
It was raised in the E-Safety committee that vehicles passing school could pick up on our frequency. In light of this, can we please be vigilant re not using the children's full names when speaking to each other.
