We use Dojo regularly to share important information, dates, photos and to communicate with each other. Please do check it regularly.

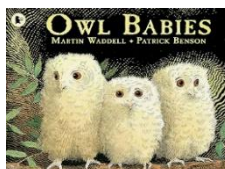
Our topic for this half term is

“Who is my family?”

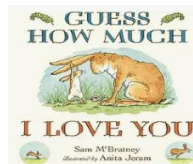
We will be learning all about ourselves, our families and our home.
