Maths

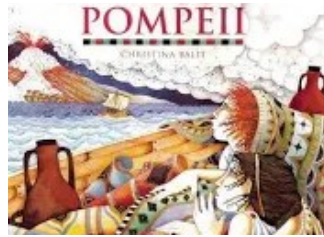
This half-term we will be continuing to look at addition and subtraction. We will then move onto multiplication and division. Please encourage your child to regularly complete activities on Mathletics and Times Table Rock Stars.



Reading

Each child has sat an assessment on Accelerated Reader to determine what level of book they will read.

Every time they finish reading a book, they complete a quiz on the book to see how much they have understood what they have read. If they score well, they receive points which increases the level of book they can choose. Children reading to an adult at home will be able to progress around our reading challenge. Eventually, they can choose a book from Mrs Dainty.



Literacy

This half-term our Literacy will be based around the book 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. This book links with our Geography topic about natural disasters.

Homework

Homework challenges will be set for each half term, where children can complete tasks of their choosing—these are optional. The children are also encouraged to spend time on Mathletics, Spelling Shed and TTRS each week.
