They will be able to explain why we have different seasons related to the position of the sun and the rotation of the Earth. They will be able to explain what the weather is like in autumn and winter and how this affects humans and wildlife. Including migration and hibernation. Children will be able to name the 4 nations that make up the UK. Children will be able to say their address. Children will be able to identify the difference between towns, cities and villages.
