Literacy

- Design a tourist leaflet encouraging people to visit Egypt, the River Nile or the Pyramids.
- Write a newspaper report about King Tutankhamun's tomb being discovered. Include a headline, paragraphs, pictures and quotes.
- Use hieroglyphics to write a message or a sentence.
- Create a wordsearch about Ancient Egypt.
- Create a fact file about an Ancient Egyptian god.
- Write a poem about either different types of forces or magnets.

Maths

- Create a graph to show the number of tourists that visit the Great Pyramids each year.
- Create some word problems to do with Egypt, their gods or the pyramids. for the children in the class to answer in lesson.
- Make a net for a pyramid.
- Create your own maths word problems using the 4 different operations.

Computing

- * Create a PowerPoint about Egypt.
- * Draw and label a diagram of a pyramid.
- * Create a Word Document/Presentation explaining the process of mummification!
