Our aim is to provide, as much as possible, a chronological approach to teaching history, once within the KS1 curriculum and again in KS2. The children have opportunities to re-visit previous topics to build upon previous learning. All units are taught with an enquiry-based approach and children have opportunities to ask and research their own questions. Staff recap and revisit learning to embed historical understanding of key dates, events and periods throughout the Historical learning journey.
