Be Reflective

- · What worked well?
- · What did not work well?
- · What important skills were needed?
- · What are the learning points to take forward?

Actively listening

- Try to look the speaker in the eye but don't stare
- · Don't interrupt the person who is talking
- · Focus on what they are saying
- . Think of questions
- · Be open-minded to their ideas
- · Use your body to show you are listening
- Give positive and honest feedback

Use your body

- Use gesture to add emphasis
- Try to make eye contact with your audience
- Project your voice so your message is heard clearly
- Think about your pace—not too fast, not too slow
- · Use pauses
- · Vary the pitch and tone of your voice
