Since Louise has taken over as the new Chair, she has had a meeting with Mrs Dainty and discussed the following:

It has been suggested by Mrs Dainty that the pupils would benefit from a wooden structure for an outdoor reading area. Louise to look into this. It will be highly published to all the parents that this is our intended fund raising project.
