## Maths

We will continue with our Mastery approach to Maths, taking smaller steps to cover topics and weaving in lots of problem solving. During the first half term we will be focussing on place value and addition and subtraction.



We'll also be having Mastering Number sessions to help children gain a deeper understanding of number bonds and different mental strategies to help them perform calculations.

## PE

For this half term, our outdoor PE day is Thursday afternoons and our indoor lessons are on Friday afternoons (both classes). ## English

This term our English will be based around the book 'The Lost Property Office' by Emily Rand. This is linked to our Geography topic about airports and train stations.

## Homework

## Spelling

Children will be taught a spelling rule at the start of each week and participate in an activity linked to this at the start of each English lesson. ## Reading

We encourage you to listen to your child read at home as much as possible so they can take lots of reading quizzes. For our reading challenge, children can claim a free book for reading 40 times with an adult. We would like to invite anyone who is interested to come in and be a mystery reader. ## Topic



In this term's Geography topic, the children will be learning all about Airports and Train stations. They will discover which are our closest airports and train stations, explore what jobs people have there and learn about what steps you have to take before you can board the plane.

## Science

In science this half term, children will be learning about different materials like plastic, glass, wood, brick and metal in our science topic, 'What would Traction Man use to build our school?'
