What ingredients did you use? What '5 star' rating would you/they give it? Take a photo and upload to Seesaw. 5 dojos</p>
<p>Design a colourful road safety poster promoting road safety. Include rules, such as "Look both ways before crossing" or "Wear a seatbelt." 3 dojos</p>	<p>Research a form of transport. When was it invented? Where is it usually used? What materials are normally used to make it? 3 dojos</p>	<p>Use drum sticks (E.g. wooden spoons) to create your own Drumba routine for the class to follow.
