**What is working well:**

**Suggestions for improving practice:**

Staggered start and finish times are a success. More relaxed feel and is less chaotic.

Takes stress away from potentially losing sight of your child.

I was surprised to hear my child has trouble completing work and is unable to control himself. Had I known, I could have supported this to correct it.

My child couldn't attend school due to pandemic. School has done it's best for her. She misses her friends and teachers.

Disappointed with the handling of forest schools. Lateness of informing parents whose children haven't been selected.

Not able to attend baking or nature club without explanation. Was told by school all he had to do was apply. He was disappointed and affected his attitude towards teachers.

Communication from the office can cause confusion at times. It needs to be clearer.

I am hoping he will need less support next year.

Maths club as he is good at maths.

Discipline should be equal amongst all children. Children should not be tiptoed around because of individual needs eg. Anger/disability.

My child will need support when she returns in September with emotions and maths.

My child is dependent on TA support and I would like her to become more independent.

Would have been good if all children could have come into school to collect work. Those with siblings had theirs collected for them.

More direct communication with parents and more parents' evenings.

Not enough feedback with his learning difficulties. Some areas he struggles with I am not aware of the support he receives.

Lunchtimes are an issue for my child. More strategies and ideas need to be explored to help with this.
