Children will be able to say why different materials are used for certain purposes.	
	Most: Core	Children will know what we mean by the term 'famous'. Children will know about a famous person from the past who lived locally and the impact they have on our lives today. Children will know about a famous person from the UK. Children will be able to identify and name some different materials and say what they are used for.	
	All: Less able	Children will be able to name some famous people from the UK. Children will know about a famous person from the past that has impacted on our lives today. Children will be able to name a few different materials and may be able to say what they are used for.
