Literacy

- Log onto Spelling Shed and practise your weekly spellings.
- Create a wordsearch using the names of different cities in the UK.
- Write a recount about a town or city that you visited. What did you see or do there?
- Write some facts about different methods of transport you might find in a city using subheadings.

Maths

- Log on to Mathletics and record the activities you completed.
- Complete some coin rubbings by rubbing a crayon (or side of a pencil) over different coins. Label the value of each coin and add up the total.
- Make a tally chart of the animals you see in your garden or the colour of cars that drive past.

ICT

- * Create a PowerPoint about a city of your choice.
- * Create a video offering some tips on how to pass a netball or rugby ball.
- * Record yourself saying some words or phrases in French.

Science

- Test out a magnet around your house. Write down which objects you discovered are magnetic.
- Design a game that uses a magnet. How can you use your knowledge of magnets to help you?
- Make an information poster about forces and magnets.
- Create a science experiment to test how an object moves over different types of surfaces.

1. Create a picture collage of European cities
2. Create top trump cards using different capital cities from around Europe
3. Create your own artwork of a skyscraper or other landmark from a city. This could be a painting, or a 3D model.
4. Complete a piece of art showing your shading skills. Sketch and shade an object in your house or garden thinking about the shapes needed and shade parts of your drawing light or dark.
5. Do some magnet marble painting. All you need is a magnetic marble, a piece of paper, a few drops of paint and a magnet.
6. Build your own magnetic compass from a few simple materials.
