1. **Welcome:** RW welcomed everyone to the meeting. Everybody agreed with the minutes from the last meeting.
2. **Feedback from safer internet day** - Chelsie explained what the Internet safety Day had consisted of. She talked about what they had learned and what were the most important points that they had taken from the internet safety sessions. The children were very enthused about the sessions and could talk freely about what they have learned. They showed the adults the letters they had handed out to the rest of the school during e-safety week. Mrs Menzies placed a section on the Newsletter that is placed on the school Website.
3. **Promoting our e-safety page on the school website - ideas to achieve this**
RW suggested that we move the internet safety link as it is unclear. AH suggested it be placed in the Key Information drop down menu.
Chelsie: suggested that pictures of the Internet Safety Week should be posted on the website. Also possibly a blog of what we have been doing from e-safety sessions.
Abbie: Steps on how to keep safe on the internet - this is already covered in 5 smart tips.

ACTION: All members to research other school's internet e-safety pages on their websites and find out what we can improve on ours.

RW suggested placing the QR code on the e-safety board linking to our webpage. AH is already researching QR code apps for the ipads in schools.

ACTION - RW will send AH a link to a QR code reader.

4. **How can the website page be improved?**

(See ideas from Chelsie in 3.)

ST: Possible letters to parents about games consoles - this was sent out before Christmas. However, may needs to be child friendly and be reminding children about the restrictions and dangers of using a games console.

Johnson: Was able to talk about the privacy policy on X-Box and told the committee about how you press a button on the console for help and this will access the privacy policy.

The children talked about a video (Jigsaw e-safety) they had seen about a man who was 'metaphorically' (Abi) there in the child's room talking about the child's information that she had put on the internet.

ACTION - Adults in e-safety committee to watch the video as it has had a huge impact on educating the children about putting personal information on line.

5. Concerns from Parents/Children/Staff:

Chelsie: Omegle/ Oovoo - websites to talk to anyone over a video streaming channel (when googled it's description is 'a chat roulette type of site') concerns that some children are using this. A friend had commented that they were using these sites at home. The children were concerned that their friends were putting themselves at risk.

ACTION - Adults to discuss course of action later in the meeting -

16.40pm - AH suggested to write another letter regarding the websites that have brought up tonight by the children and to seek the advice from the DCC documentation about selfie cop.

KW: There have been problems in the media around a nursery being scrutinised for using photos of children in individual learning journeys. KW will be presenting a letter that she wishes to send out to parents to seek permission to be able to use photographs of all children in learning journeys. The committee agreed this was the best course of action.

ST: concerns around her own child in Year 3 asking about joining facebook, as a parent it is worrying that children are gaining knowledge of social media sites at such a young age.

6. **E-safety video** - Idea from the last meeting, children would like to make an e-safety video to get the message across to the rest of the school using familiar role models. This could be shown during parent mornings and parent consultations. AH asked if any adults had the time to make the video with the children. RW suggested that the children went away and wrote a script for the video.

ACTION - Children to write a script and a storyboard for the e-safety video possibly over lunchtime.

7. **Whisper:** AH reported 4 incidents from the last meeting, the last one was from a parent which was good to see as parents are monitoring children's use of the internet at home. AH keeps the reports from Whisper and annotates
