Literacy

- How many different plants can you think of? Write a plant alphabet (A is for, B is for etc.)
- Visit a home from the past and write a fact file about it.
- Write your own encyclopaedia of household items from the past.
- Create a poem about a beautiful garden or park.

Maths

- Practical fractions—Can you take some photos of fractions you have made at home. Could you use building blocks to create fractions of a shape? Could you share out objects into fractions?
- Create a tally chart of the plants you can find in your garden or local park.

ICT

1. Create a PowerPoint presentation about different types of homes.
2. Research and create a poster on the Venus Fly Trap.
3. Record a video clip to explain how technology has transformed our lives.

Science

1. Design your own plant. Where does it grow best? What does it need to grow well? How does it spread its seeds or pollen? How many leaves does it have? What are the flowers like? What fruit does it produce?
2. Plant something from a seed. Show with drawings/ photos how the plant develops over the term.
3. Compare two different flowers and explain the difference and similarities.
4. Draw and label the parts of a flowering plant. Write a sentence to explain their function.

1. Create your own outdoor 3D sculpture garden ornament. Take a photograph of it and upload it to SeeSaw.
2. Look out for interesting flowers and plants in the garden and when on walks. Photograph them and create your own collage or scrapbook.
3. Make a model plant or a pollinating insect.
4. Have a go at making your own flowers using different materials - eg. clay or paper
5. Design and create a home of the future!
6. Plan and design your own 'dream garden', include all the aspects that you believe a garden should have.
