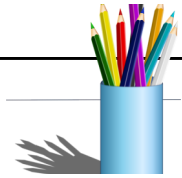




Year 4 News

PE

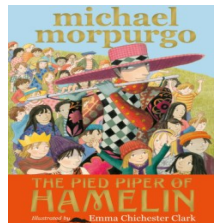

Literacy

Science
