PE



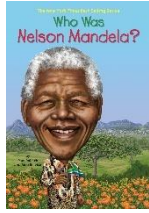

Reading

English



Our English lessons for this half term will be linked to our history topic where we will be learning to write Biographies. Children will write a biography based on Rosa Parks.

Spelling



We will be focussing on a different spelling rule each week. The children will be taught the rule on Mondays, and complete activities each day within our English. There will be no weekly spelling tests. Children have access to Spelling Shed games using a username and password in their reading records..
