<p>Create an eye-catching poster about famous black people that have contributed to improving our world. It could include pictures, bold words (eg. fairness, peace, change the world, respect, courage) and quotes.</p> <p>5 dojos</p>	<p>Bake something. Write the recipe and instructions for what you made.</p> <p>You can send pictures of your baking on Seesaw!</p> <p>5 dojos</p>	<p>Make your own model with play-dough, air-dry clay or clay. (We will be learning how to use clay to make sculptures in school this half term.)</p> <p>6 dojos</p>
<p>Make an art sculpture using natural materials (such as leaves, twigs and petals). This could be stuck onto paper and a photo taken and uploaded to Seesaw.</p> <p>4 dojos</p>	<p>Research one of these significant people from History - Rosa Parks, Nelson Mandela or Barack Obama. Find out when they were born and why they are famous</p> <p>4 dojos</p>	<p>Create your own video sharing some tips on something related to Maths. This could include tips on how to add, subtract, multiply, divide, count money etc.</p> <p>4 dojos</p>
<p>Write your own film review for a movie you have watched. What was it about? Who were the main characters? What was your favourite part? What rating would you give it?</p> <p>3 dojos</p>	<p>Collect different leaves and create some wax crayon leaf rubbings.</p> <p>3 dojos</p>	<p>Draw and label the main parts of a tree including leaves, branches, twigs, roots, trunk and crown.</p> <p>3 dojos</p>
<p>Practise your handwriting. Join your writing to write these words. Your name, class name, school name and parents name. Remember your joins.</p> <p>2 dojos</p>	<p>This half term's Longmoor Value is 'Curious'. What does being curious mean? Write what the word curious means to you / draw a picture.</p> <p>2 dojos</p>	<p>Write divisions for the 2x, 10x or 5x table (eg. $5 \div 5 = 1$, $10 \div 5 = 2$, $15 \div 5 = 3$)</p> <p>2 dojos</p>
