Dear parents and carers

Wrap Around Care Provision – September 2026

I am writing to inform you that, due to rising operational costs, we have no choice but to increase our wraparound care charges from next academic year, 2026-2027.

To ensure high-quality, sustainable care despite rising costs, we are adjusting our fees with effect from 1st September 2026. The new rates will be as follows:

Breakfast Club - £5.00 per session, with a drop off time from 7.30am. Please note, this earlier drop off time will be available for all parents. We have noticed that many of you are often waiting for the 7.45am drop off time, so we are hoping that this slightly earlier time will make your life easier.

After School Club - £9.00 per session, with a collection time of any time up to 6.00pm for all parents, Monday to Friday.

We aim to support families by suggesting checking eligibility for **tax free childcare**. We are officially Ofsted-registered as a childcare provider, which means that parents can use the scheme to contribute towards the cost of wrap around care. Our unique reference number (URN) is 112585,

Through this scheme, for every £8 you pay into your online account, the government will automatically add £2, giving you up to £2,000 per child per year (or £4,000 for disabled children) to offset costs.

If you find you are eligible, please contact myself or one of the school office team, and we will be happy to explain the process to you.

We assure you that we aim to keep our wrap around care costs as low as possible, and that we do not operate the clubs on a profit basis. However, this academic year, we have unfortunately made a loss due to increasing costs, therefore, without this slight cost increase, the clubs are not sustainable. We are hoping that the slight increase will mean we can continue to offer this valuable service to our parents. We hope you understand and support this decision.
