PE

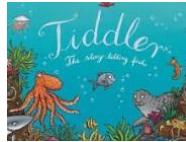

Autumn 1 2026

English



We will start the year focusing on Rainbow Grammar and laying down the foundation of what the children will need to help them become successful, confident writers. Later in the term, our English lessons will be based on the book Tiddler by Julia Donaldson. This book links with our Science topic about Habitats.

Homework

Children will receive optional homework challenges and they can be completed at their own pace.



Reading

Each child will sit a reading assessment on a program called Accelerated Reader, which will inform us of what level of book they need to read. Every time they finish reading a book, they need to do a quiz in school, which is based on the book to help us find out how much they understood.

In addition to this, we have our class Reading Challenge. Children will move around the challenge with every 5 reads with an adult and claim a free book for reading 40 times.

Spelling

Children will learn a different spelling rule each week in class. They will be taught the rule on Mondays, and then complete an activity each day within our English lessons.

Topic

This term's History Topic is 'Who are Britain's significant monarchs?' and the children will learn about 5 of Britain's most famous Kings and Queens.



Science

Our Science topic this term is called 'Why do animals choose the habitats they have?'

Children will compare living things and their habitats and explore the idea of food chains between plants and animals.
