Maths

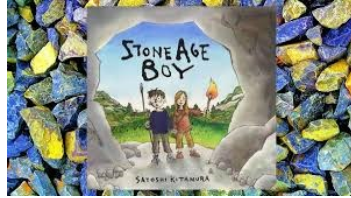
During the first half term, we will be working on place value, addition and subtraction. We will spend some time on each topic, taking a small step approach with the aim of mastering the learning and then moving on to using and applying the maths in to reason and problem solve.



Reading

Each child has sat an assessment on Accelerated Reader to determine what level of book they will read. Every time they finish reading a book, they complete a quiz on the book to see how much they have understood what they have read. If they score well, they receive points which increases the level of book they can choose. Children reading to an adult at home will be able to progress around our reading challenge. Eventually, they can choose a book from Mrs Dainty.
