

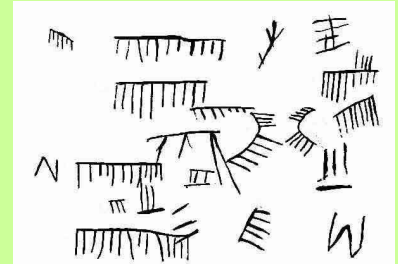
Homework Challenges Autumn 1

Do some further independent learning...choose as many as you like! We will be sharing our homework with the class on a weekly basis.

Maths

◇ Learn your times tables, especially your 3s, 4s and 8s.

◇ Stone Age people didn't understand numbers as we do. Archaeologists have found these markings in caves that they think might be stone age counting. Can you come up with your own way of recording counting? You might want to use symbols to represent certain amounts. Will you count in sets of 10 or will your counting system work differently?



Science

- * Find 10 facts about bones and muscles.—use this website to help you—<http://www.theschoolrun.com/homework-help/bones-and-muscles>
- * Research: Which foods contain the most amount of protein? What about carbohydrates and fats?
- * Create a poster advertising the functions of a human skeleton. Explain why it is better than other types of skeletons.
- * Keep a food diary of all the meals you eat for a week.

1. Build a model stone circle. You could do this in your garden or in a shoe box lid. Look for some small suitable sized stones/pebbles. You will need at least 10 and remember that about 1/4 of them will be underground so that they stand up (dampening the soil will help). Take a picture of your stone circle and stick it in your book.

2. Cave homes: During the Stone Age people lived in caves. If you had to live in a cave what would you like it to look like and what would be in it? Be imaginative and creative! Perhaps you could build your own 3D cave?!

3. Stone Age Recipe: Stone Age people could not pop into the shops for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your own recipe for a Stone Age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would have been available to them.

Literacy

- Write a report about an animal that would have lived in the Stone Age.
- Write your own fact book about one aspect of the Stone Age e.g. homes, food, tools.
- Create a PowerPoint presentation all about the Stone Age.
- Research and make notes about another country from the Stone Age and present your facts on a poster.
