Choose your creative challenge from the menu below:

The Peri-ometer suggests the difficulty or challenge the homework may offer. Over the half term we would love to see your creativity based on the tasks below uploaded to Seesaw or shared in school.

Remember: TT Rockstars, Mathletics and Spelling Shed should be accessed weekly. Make sure you read to an adult to make your way around the reading challenge. (Don't forget to ask them to sign it.)

Build your own royal palace or castle that would be fit for a king or queen using furniture, cushions and blankets that parents allow you to use. Create a throne in your fort and share a picture of you reading on your throne.

Create your own 3D model of a habitat. Think about how you can include the plants and animals found in this habitat.

You can send pictures of your model on Seesaw or bring it into school.

Design and play your own board game. Come up with rules and make your own board and game pieces. Once the game is complete, play it with family or friends.
