MR took us through the Treasurer's report (see attached). We started the 2023 school year with a balance of £4,502.33. MR highlighted that it had been again a successful year for the PTFA. Despite the Summer Fayre being held in-doors due to the weather, it generated £3480.77 (before costings) It is worth being mindful that the cost of hiring inflatables has risen and it may not always be possible to break even.

The Longmoor PTFA continues to be a member of Parentkind, with a cost of £183, this covers PTFA insurance and guidance.

The funds raised has enabled an additional £4,000 of resources for the school. From maths equipment, books about diversity and a contribution to renovate the pond area.
